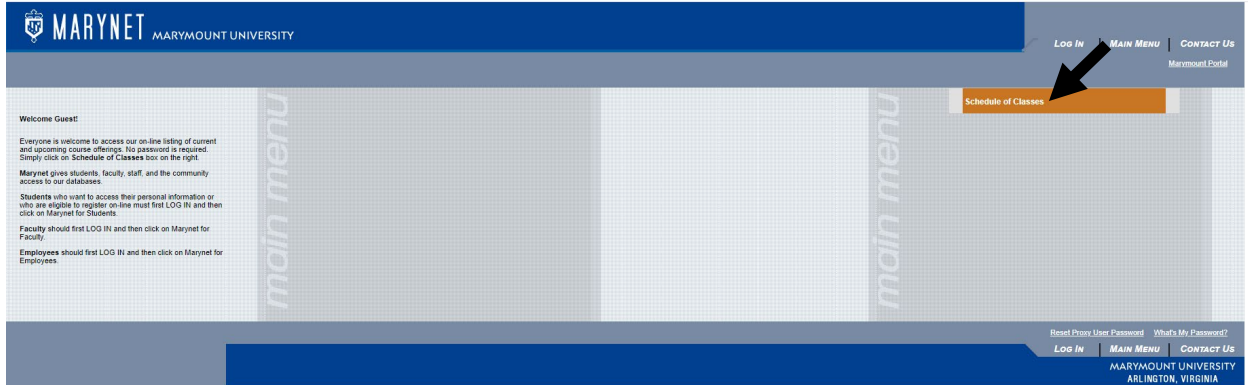
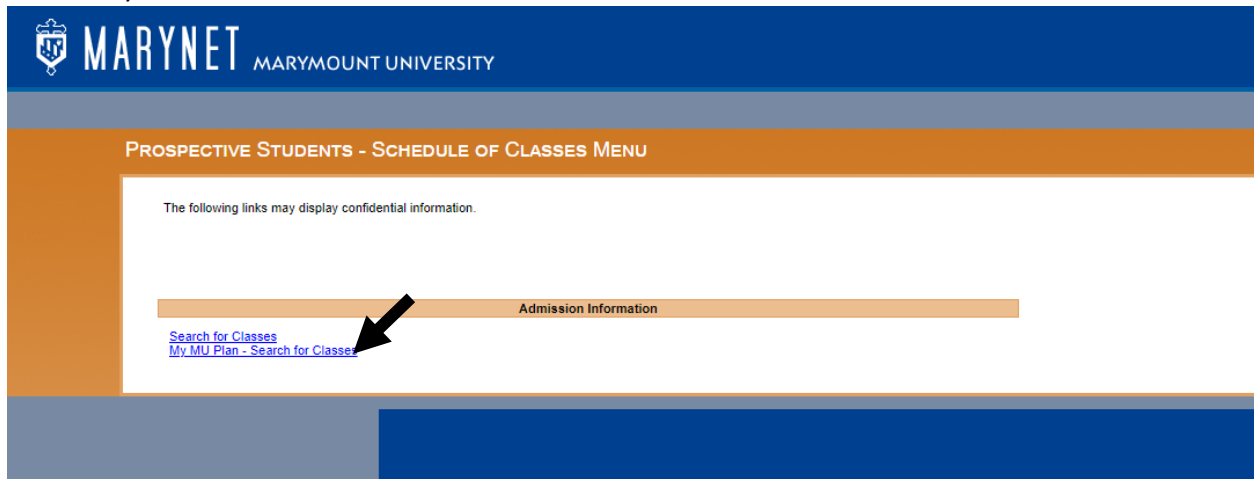


## Searching for Mini-Mester courses in My MU Plan

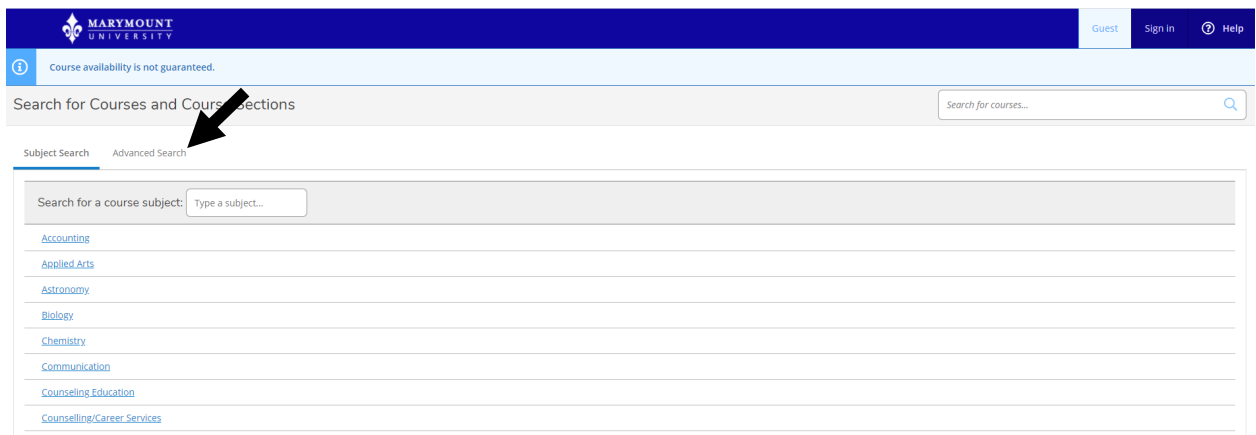
1. Go to Marynet (marynet.marymount.edu).
