



## International Graduate Student I-20 Checklist

An I-20 is a certificate of eligibility for nonimmigrant (F-1) student visa status. Marymount issues the I-20 for admitted students who submit the following items:

- Confirm your Graduate Enrollment**  
The first step to enrolling is to submit the non-refundable program deposit, if applicable, and enrollment form in the [application portal](#). Program deposits are required for **Counseling, D.Sc. in Cybersecurity, Forensic and Legal Psychology, Physical Therapy, and Nursing programs.**

- Copy of passport ID pages**  
Passport must be valid for at least six months beyond the start of the semester

- A completed [International Student Supplemental Information \(ISSI\) form](#)**

- [Declarations of Finances Form](#) and proof of financial support**  
An official, original bank statement from you and/or your sponsor(s) demonstrating specified sum in U.S. dollars. This statement must be signed and stamped by a bank official and dated no earlier than six months prior to the issuing of the I-20. If you have been awarded a scholarship from Marymount, you may deduct the amount of the scholarship from the total amount required. *Photocopies of statements are not acceptable.* See [specified sums under bank statements](#)

Students currently in the U.S., transferring from another U.S. institution must also submit:

- A completed [Transfer Clearance Form](#)**
- Photocopies of all previous I-20 forms**
- Photocopies of all previous U.S. visas**
- Photocopy of the front and back of I-94 card (arrival/departure record)**

### Document Deadlines

It is recommended you submit your documents early, particularly if you will be applying for a new F-1 visa. All documents listed above must be uploaded to your [application portal](#) no later than the deadline below:

Fall semester:	July 1 (Outside of the US) and August 1 (Inside the US)
Spring semester:	November 1 (Outside of the US) and January 2 (Inside the US)
Summer semester:	March 1 (Outside of the US) and May 1 (Inside the US)

- Payment of the SEVIS fee is a requirement before applying for your F-1 student visa or if you have a new initial I-20**
