- 1. Set up and access your [Marymount account](#)
- 2. Log in to your [Marymount Portal](#) account which has access to all the applications you need. Including your new Google Marymount email account, Canvas, Marynet, Handshake and Engage.
- 3. Upload your medical records on the [Medical portal](#)
- 4. Complete all the [Undergraduate](#) or [Graduate](#) Orientation programs
- 5. Pay special attention to complete the [Immigration online International Student Orientation modules](#) on Canvas
- 6. Get Ready for class registration
 - First year students take the [Directed Self-Placement \(DSP\)](#).
 - Transfer students contact [Academic advising center](#).
 - Graduate students contact your program school for academic advising.
- 7. Join the [MU International Student Group 21/22](#) on Facebook!
Ask questions, meet your peer advisor and other international students
- 8. Submit your documentation to admission to [obtain an I-20](#) (F-1 visa students only)
- 9. Pay the [Sevis Fee](#) (Initial I-20 only)
- 10. Read your [pre-arrival guide](#), which includes all the information you need to get ready for your studies.
- 11. Apply for the [F-1 Visa](#) (If you're outside the U.S)
- 12. Apply for [Housing](#)
- 13. Book your flight to the U.S. Plan to arrive **NO EARLIER THAN 07/23 AND NO LATER THAN 08/23**
- 14. Go to [Marynet \(MU Portal\)](#) and pay your tuition or set up a payment plan.
- 15. Read the International Student Services News e-mails.
