MARYMOUNT UNIVERSITY NOTES

Communication major has a Sports Communication specialization. This specialization would be completed in lieu of the 21 credits of Communication electives. Students interested in this specialization may want to consider the following courses at MC: MGMT 211 (equivalent to MKT 301, required course for Sports Comm specialization); COMM 225 (equivalent to COMM 220, elective course for Sports Comm specialization); COMM 112 (equivalent to COMM 310, elective course for Sports Comm specialization).

Most minors at Marymount are 15 credits, or 12 additional credits if students have taken a course in the minor field such as communications, sociology, political science, law, or psychology.

‡‡‡ Most Communication Studies electives count as either requirements or electives for the Communication major at Marymount; see the Marymount website for an updated list. Each COMM course taken at Montgomery College that also counts as a Marymount Communication requirement or elective reduces the total number of Communication requirement or elective courses needed to be taken at Marymount.
