To determine eligibility for any type of financial aid, we must construct an Educational Cost of Attendance (COA) budget for each student. These COA's are assigned using standard costs for living and transportation, etc. A student cannot receive financial aid that exceeds their COA.

Sometimes, a student has expenses unique to their personal living situation which would be unknown to us. Regulations allow us to collect individual expenses to review and possibly increase the overall COA, which will allow for additional financial aid. Please note, the Appeal Committee can only consider amounts that are in addition to what the University has already accounted for in your COA. In addition, we may not be able to use all expenses submitted depending on the type of expense. Decisions by the appeal committee are final.

Select category for your expense (check all that apply). Receipts must be submitted for **all** documented expenses.

- Housing (lease or proof of mortgage payment required)
- Medical and dental payments not covered by insurance
- Purchase of a laptop or computer (\$2000 increase limit on laptop/ computer purchases)
- Dependent care
- Disability related expenses not covered by a state or other agency
- Other unusual or mitigating expenses

You may not consider a COA appeal for the following reasons:

- Car Payments
- Purchase of a New Vehicle
- Student Loan Payments
- Credit Card Debt
