Parking

University parking is strictly limited to Marymount students, faculty and staff possessing a valid parking pass who are currently working or attending classes at Ballston Center.

For questions about getting a parking pass or where you can park, please contact the ID & Parking Office at 703-284-5700.

The parking garage is located on the backside of the building off of North Wakfield Street which can be accessed directly from Fairfax Drive or 11th Street from Glebe and follow the road around to your left.

There are two entry lanes and one exit lane to the garage. You must have a Marymount parking hang tag and will use your Marymount ID in order to swipe in and out of the garage.

Elevators

After parking, there are two sets of elevators. Only one set is designated for use by Marymount University faculty, staff and students.

The parking elevators will take you to the following floors only: P2, P1, Ground (1), 2. For those utilizing the floors above 2, you should exit at the 2 nd floor and proceed to the building elevator lobby.

The shuttle drop-off area is behind the building on North Wakefield Street, and you will enter the building at a side door located in the courtyard between the new residence building and Marymount University Ballston Center. As you proceed through the doors down the hallway, you will turn left at the end of the hall. Proceed down the next hallway past the glass doors on your right, you will then enter the elevator access area on your right just past the glass doors.
